**New Jersey Local Information Network Communication System (NJLINCS) is a no cost, statewide public health emergency notification system that links together public health, health care, and community partners. This emergency notification system is used to disseminate critical public health information through alerts, advisories, updates, and information on health topics such as communicable disease outbreaks, Influenza, Covid-19, West Nile, monkey pox, rabies advisory, and food recalls.**
